2. Aims and objectives of your **organisation**; What does your organisation do and how does it benefit the residents of Yateley, Frogmore and Darby Green?

Yateley Life Saving Club train young people, age ranging from 9 years to adults, in land and water based lifesaving skills. This includes first aid and CPR (resuscitation) lessons. We train our younger members using the Royal Life Saving Society (RLSS) Rookie Lifeguard Programme in which they learn how to keep themselves, friends and family safe in and around water. They also learn basic methods to rescue casualties from the water and what to do in an emergency situation. For our older members we train them using the RLSS Survive and Save Programme, this includes more advanced CPR and First Aid training, using baby, child and adult manikins, choking vest and manikin, bandaging, and hopefully soon a AED training aid. We also train parents, grandparents and carers in how to save a baby's life in conjunction with the local children's centres.
The more people that learn CPR skills the more lives can be saved.

We would like to purchase a Training Automated External Defibrillator (AED) in order to train not only our club members in how to use one but also be able to demonstrate it to other members of the wider community so that people are not scared to use a defibrillator should the need arise to save another person's life. As AED's are now becoming more visible on the high street and available for anyone to use it is important that people are not afraid of using one. We wish to add the Training AED to our club's training equipment as the RLSS have revised many of their life support awards to include AED use, so wish to be able to give our members practice in how an AED works.

As Yateley now has an AED situated outside one of the public houses, it is essential that community members are not afraid to use it, should the need arise. We aim to start by training our own club members in using an AED, also engaging with their parents to learn CPR and the use of an AED, demonstrating it during our Save A Babys' Life workshops that are run for local parents, grandparents and carers through the local children's centres and to work with other community groups to broaden the number of people who have been shown how to use an AED, hopefully saving lives in the process.

9. Please tell us how this funding will lead to greater self sufficiency and lessen the need for future applications.

Once Yateley Life Saving Club has an AED Trainer, we have the ability needed to demonstrate how to use an AED to a great number of people without the need to purchase any further equipment, thus providing the club with a very beneficial piece of equipment.

10. How is your organisation normally funded?

Our club is non-profit making and all our Instructors and Committee are volunteers, the cost of pool and room hire is funded by the fees we charge per person for each of the courses we teach.

11. What are your current subs/fees/charges?

Current club charges are between £65 and £70 per term for classes between 45 minutes and 90 minutes per week (term time only)

We have secured £125 donation from the RLSS Surrey Branch as part of the RLSS 125 year celebration towards the AED Trainer.

We had a raffle for a club sweatshirt last month and have planned another raffle at our Awards Evening /AGM in September. These will cover the cost of the anti-bacterial wipes we use during our training sessions.

We anticipate that our membership will stay steady and that this will cover the pool and room hire costs, including the annual increase and any weekly running costs. We do not require any further equipment in the coming year, however we will need to train some more instructors which we will have to pay for resources for. We do not anticipate any deficit or a great surplus in the coming year. Attached are our latest accounts and bank statements.
