### **CAPITAL PROJECTS**

Members reviewed, in detail, the list of potential projects for capital expenditure from the 2016/17 budget of £20,000.

It was **RESOLVED** to go ahead with CCTV around the Tythings/ carpark £11,000, Re-colouring of the tennis courts £4300 and the purchase of three new benches £400 per bench, with Cllr Crisp sponsoring one.

The following items were **NOTED** and taken forward for future discussion.

- Upgrading the public toilets
- Installing basketball post on the tennis courts- awaiting grant application from HPFA
- New Litter Bins- Cllr Barnes looking into sponsorship from local businesses.
- Inclusive swing seat for existing swings on Yateley Green- talking with potential suppliers
- Upgrades to Monteagle Centre- aim for a three year rolling programme. Project to be scoped.
- Multiuse shelter Yateley Green- On hold until after Youth Café is built.
- Two new bus shelters for centre of town- Aim to purchase one this year and one next year.
- Frogmore ditch work- To be included in this year's winter programme.
- Darby Green Pond- Cllr Hennell and Murr meeting to discuss project.
- All street lighting requests to be given to the Finance and Policy Committee for consideration.

Members agreed that there were many projects they would like to see undertaken and **RESOLVED** to ask the Finance and Policy Committee to increase the 2016/17 capital projects budget from £20,000 to £40000.

Members agreed to make a list of specific examples and look into what the Town Council could do.

**INFORMATION ITEMS**

Members **NOTED** the previous items updates.

Lengthsman Scheme- Yateley to lead a cluster of parishes. Members would like to see more funding given to the scheme. For future discussion.

Heathlands Cemetery- All non- compliant graves surveyed. Hope to complete restoration by the end of May.

The new latch for the Tythings front door was proving problematic but hoped to be resolved soon.
